Coroner's Certificate - \$75

When a coroner is to provide a **Form 14** Certificate for Transportation Outside of Ontario or a **Form 26** Certificate of Cremation, a fee set by Solicitor General of the Province of Ontario is paid to the coroner for providing such a document as necessary.

Cremation Fees

This fee is paid to the crematorium of the family's choice for providing the services of cremation of the deceased.

District Registration – \$15

This fee is paid to the Amprior Town Hall to register the loss of a loved one. Where a burial certificate is than provided for use at time of Burial or a cremation.

PAYMENT

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 15 days of signing of a funeral home contract. Payment may be made by cash, cheque or money order. If payment in full is not made within the 15 days allotted time period, interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5% per month (18% annually) compounded monthly until payment is received in full.

FUNDING FOR PRE-PAID FUNERALS

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services and supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today and the funds will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

- 1. **TRUST** You may pay the money directly to us and we will place the funds in trust where they will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered). In the event of a cancellation after 30 days, a cancellation fee of 10% of accrued interest up to a maximum of \$350 applies.
- 2. INSURANCE You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services and supplies at the time they are delivered. In the event of a cancellation, the contract will be cancelled and the purchaser may ask for a refund payable to him/her. This same insurance contract can be re-assigned to a new funeral provider as directed by the purchaser without an exchange of funds.
